#### In case of evacuation

When you hear an evacuation message over the PA system or the fire alarm sounds, take the following steps:







Proceed to the Assembly Point.



Do NOT return to the building until management or emergency services personnel tell you that you may.

#### If you're conducting an academic activity

You're responsible for assisting the students under your care.

Tell students to leave the premises.


Direct them to the nearest stairway or exit and remind them where the Assembly Point is.



If you're in a laboratory,
Stop processes that cannot be left unattended for safety reasons.



Make sure no one remains on the premises and close the door as you leave. Don't lock the door.





Assist students, especially anyone who may experience difficulties during the evacuation.
Students with disabilities or those using crutches








### If you discover a FIRE









### In case of a lockdown

A lockdown is a measure aimed at protecting people by having them stay inside a building until it's safe to leave.

If you hear a lockdown message over the PA system or UPC staff tell you a lockdown is in effect.



Close all exterior windows and doors.

Turn off air-conditioning and ventilation systems.
