


In case of evacuation

When you hear an evacuation message over the PA system or the fire alarm sounds, take the following steps:







If you're leading a guided activity or other sports activity

Stop any guided activities.

Turn off any portable music systems that may prevent people from hearing the evacuation message or fire alarm.



Tell participants attending your class to leave the premises.

Direct them to the nearest stairway or exit and remind them where the Assembly Point is.



Make sure no one remains in the changing rooms or sauna.

Once the evacuation has started, **prevent students from re-entering** the space to collect personal belongings.



4 Assist participants, especially anyone who may experience difficulties during the evacuation.

People with disabilities or those using crutches.




Remember that the North Campus Sports Centre is equipped with intercoms to facilitate communication in case of a medical or other emergency.

In case of a lockdown

A lockdown is a measure aimed at protecting people by having them stay inside a building until it's safe to leave.

If you hear a lockdown message over the PA system or UPC staff tell you a lockdown is in effect.







In relation to sports centre users



Remind sports centre users that they must stay inside the building. Gather them together in the court area (floor S2).
